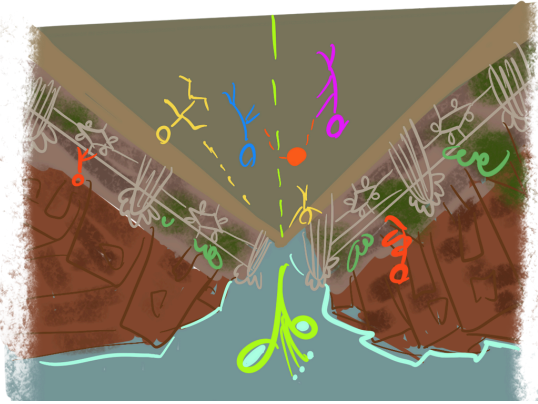


Growth house uplifts Black immigrant

COMMUNITY POWER**

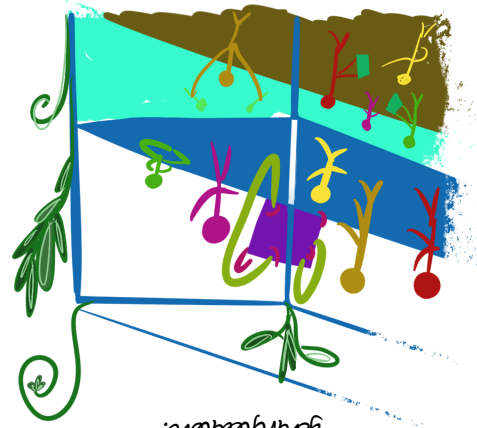
We transitioned from art to real

unfurnished floors in their Bed-Stuy
home into a creative lab for young
people of color. It became a place for
art, expression, healing, and
organizing in the midst of rapid
gentrification.

We focus on
reclaiming land
across Central
Brooklyn. Our
organizing is
centered in
neighborhoods
like Bed-Stuy,
Crown Heights,
Fort Greene,
Ocean Hill,
Clinton Hill,
Prospect Heights,
and Broadway
Junction - places
where Black
culture has
shaped the city.



We're activating 375 Stuyvesant
Avenue as a civic sanctuary. The
People's Mansion will be a
home for healing, strategy, and
collective visioning among Black
communities.
